Dear Sisters and Brothers Christ,

Grace and peace to you in the name of our God, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Last night I watched a documentary on Teddy Roosevelt which aired on PBS. It reminded me of a quote from Roosevelt that I had tucked away some time back and had forgotten about. With Mothers' Day just around the corner, I felt it was the perfect time to pull that quote out and share with you.

"When all is said, it is the mother, and the mother only, who is the better citizen than the soldier who fights for his country. The successful mother, the mother who does her part rearing and training aright the boys and girls who are to be the men and women of the next generation, is of greater use to the community, and occupies, if she would only realize it, a more honorable as well as a more important position than any man in it. The mother is the one supreme asset of the national life. She is more important, by far, than the successful statesman, or businessman, or artist, or scientist."

While the roles of men and women have changed a bit since the time of Teddy Roosevelt, I still believe the heart of what Roosevelt was referring to is still true—Mom's have an incredible impact on their children—in most cases, more so than anyone else. As such, Mom's have a great impact on our communities, our nation, and our world. And, if we were to compare the cumulative sacrifices made by the faithful mothers of this world versus our faithful service personnel and government leaders and business people and artists and all the people in their various callings, there is none that truly could compare to moms.

William Makepeace Thackeray put it this way, *"Mother is the name of God in the lips and hearts of little children."* So, on behalf of all of us who are or ever were little children, "Thank you, Mom, for being you and for loving us." And, "Thank you God for giving us mothers!"

Ancient Jewish proverb: *"God could not be everywhere and therefore He made mothers."*

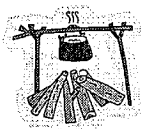

John Berry Concert Event

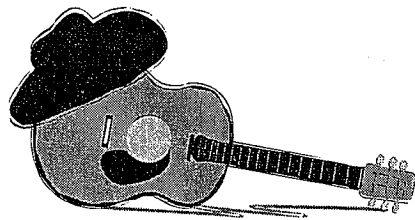
Eksjo church has the rare and unique opportunity to host a concert by famous country singer and songwriter, John Berry.


