Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Grace and peace to you in the name of our God, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

In July, many of us naturally focus on Independence Day. When I look to that day, I often reflect on those men and women who have served our nation on the front lines of battle and I ache for the yet unhealed wounds that many still carry. And, when I think of those wounds, I often think of the many unhealed wounds the rest of us might carry from battles of other sorts . . .

*Then (Jesus) went about among the villages teaching. He called the twelve and began to send them out two by two, and gave them authority over the unclean spirits. He ordered them to take nothing for their journey except a staff; no bread, no bag, no money in their belts; but to wear sandals and not put on two tunics. He said to them, "Wherever you enter a house, stay there until you leave the place. If any place will not welcome you and they refuse to hear you, as you leave, shake off the dust that is on your feet as a testimony against them." So they went out and proclaimed that all should repent. They cast out many **demons**, and anointed with oil many who were sick and **cured** them.*

[Mark 6:6b-13]

Even though he died back in 1993, Dr. William R. Parker is still remembered for his pioneering study of prayer and his work in the field of healing through the practice of prayer. A psychology professor at Redlands University in California, Dr. Parker said that when he returned from World War II his life was outwardly ideal but inwardly in great turmoil. The campus where he served was serene, his daughters were a great joy, and there was no obvious discord or strain—but the war had left him inwardly scarred. Although he was a psychologist, a professional in the field of the mind, his ailments, and the treatments of such ailments, he was plagued by what he called "**four demons**" — *hate, fear, inferiority, and guilt*. He found that despite all his best efforts, pure psychological therapy didn't result in healing. Ultimately this failure of his chosen field drove him to a scientific study on the power of prayer. Dr. Parker's life was changed. His demons were exorcised, cast out! Such was the case, as well, with many of the people involved in his research.

In the colorful language of the New Testament many inner turmoils and conflicts were termed "**demon possession**." Christ Jesus, who has been given authority over heaven and earth, said that we need not be slaves to these churning emotions. No, he promised to give us power to cast them out of our lives and out of the lives of others. And, a huge part of that promise comes in and through the practice of prayer!

As Dr. Parker discovered and documented through scientific study, there is power in prayer—there is healing to be had. As we submit ourselves completely to our God, as we allow ourselves to become truly vulnerable to him, not just in times of great turmoil but at all times, we can look to Christ Jesus for effective change, and our lives become decidedly different. We are no longer tormented by these frustrating "**demons**" but instead live in wholeness in the hands of Christ!
